

Minutes of the 24th Meeting of VSHFA held on 17th February 2026 on Zoom.

1. The meeting was called to order by 2nd Vice President Shri Pavan Kumar Sindhi at 09.00 pm sharp, he welcomed members present.
2. Roll Call was obtained and the following members were present:

3. The Minutes of the 23rd Meeting of VSHFA were confirmed unanimously.
4. National Treasurer Dr. Pitambhar Dhalwani presented his report to the group and requested the members to raise any questions or clarifications regarding the report.
5. A detailed discussion was held regarding the program scheduled on 13th May 2026 in Mumbai and the Annual General Body Meeting scheduled on 4th and 5th April 2026 in Lucknow. The respected Core Committee members present offered very valuable suggestions after a thorough and positive discussion as below.

- The Core Committee members should, if possible, arrive in Lucknow on 3rd April 2026. On 4th April 2026, the election should be conducted through the Legal Committee, and the Election Officers should be appointed. The election process should be properly followed.
- The official website should be launched at the earliest so that people can register and join through it.
- Meanwhile, the website has been developed in Mumbai and has been shared in the group. Members are requested to review it. The website development charge is ₹24,000 (Rupees Twenty-Four Thousand only), and the Maintenance charges including website domain, website maintenance and website hosting will be Rs 8000/ year.
- At least 200 member representatives of the associations should attend the Lucknow program. Each and every coordinator appointed by the VSHFA Core Committee should introduce at least one association to the Federation at the district or city level.
- Core Committee members should register their respective Trust / Panchayat / Association / Society as soon as possible. If possible, Advisors may also join the VSHFA through an organisation; however, this remains optional for them. Advisors who are not registered now may do so later .
- It was also suggested that, after the Annual General Body Meeting, a visit to Ayodhya may be organized. The Lucknow team can plan and manage the tour programme efficiently
- It was informed that the representatives who are absent may attend the AGM through an authorization letter. The procedure regarding voting by authorized representatives or through online mode will be verified from the competent authority and the same will be communicated accordingly.
- It was suggested by Hon. Shankar Lalwani ji that the agenda, election process, and duties of all concerned during the AGM should be planned very well in advance.

- It was also discussed that new associations may be formed with the support of the Core Committee, so that the maximum number of associations can become part of the Federation. Further planning should be carried out in two parts: one focusing on the election process and the other on finalising agenda for the foundation to work on.
 - The coordinators' names can be shared in the group, and the appointment letters should be drafted and sent to them. Any suggestions can also be discussed within the group itself.
 - It was also suggested that the locally elected corporators (Nagar Sevaks) should be invited to such programs, as this would help in positive image building and overall goodwill.
 - Mr Raju Manwani has been requested by Sri Raja Ram to prepare draft minute to minute program for 3rd, 4th and 5th April 26 so that further details of arrangements can be planned.
 - The age limit for the youth program scheduled on 13th May 2026 should be below 50 years. However it will be further found out from a political organization say BJP.
 - Shri Rajaram Bhagwani ji has been appointed to coordinate with the legal team for the election process and all related legal matters. Advisors such as Shri Manohar Mamatani ji and Dr. Ravi Prakash Tekchandani ji will also be included in this process.
6. Proper guidance was provided by Shri Shankar Lalwani ji regarding the Delhi program. As per the guidance of Shri Shankar Lalwani ji and Dr. Ravi Prakash Tekchandani ji, the concerned persons have been informed and are following the same. They will continue to give regular updates in the group.
