

**Minutes of the 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting of VSHFA held on 21<sup>st</sup> April 2026  
at 09.15 pm on Zoom.**

1. The meeting was called to order at 09.15 pm sharp by the National President, Dr. Gurmukh Jagwani,

4. The minutes of the previous meeting, read by National General Secretary Dr. Raju Manwani, were approved by all, with minor changes suggested by Shri Rajaram Bhagwani

5. National General Secretary Dr. Raju Manwani presented a report on the hotel visits conducted today, including the names of the hotels and their prices, as detailed below. Room charges range from ₹1,500 to ₹5,000 per head per day on a twin-sharing basis.

8. He also informed about the sponsorships received: ₹10,00,000 + ₹2,00,000 from Shri Vicky B. Kandhari, ₹25,000 from Shri Rajiv Purswani, and ₹5,000 from Dr. Vaishnavi Premchandani

11. National Treasurer Dr. Pitamber Dhalwani ji has presented his report and asked if there were any queries, as all details had already been shared in the group for members to review. He suggested that the registration charges should be kept at ₹1,000 per delegate, as the package includes two lunches, breakfast, dinner, Mumbai Darshan, and other arrangements. He further suggested that transport facility should be provided only to VVIPs so that delegates can reach the destination directly. This proposal was unanimously approved by everyone, and it was agreed that the charges should be implemented as suggested.
12. On 12th May 2026, there will be a Core Committee Meeting, which may be held at Rang Sharda, Bandra. On 13th May 2026, the Election, approval of Agenda by General body as well as Amendment and Meeting will be conducted. On 14th May 2026, there will be breakfast followed by Mumbai Darshan, and thereafter, delegates will depart directly.
13. Regarding the election, Shri Manohar Mamtani ji and Shri Rajaram Bhagwani ji gave their suggestions. The timing of the election will be decided as per the suggestion of Advocate Shyam Dewani, considering that the quorum must

be fulfilled. At least 40% presence is required, and voting can be conducted both physically as well as online.

14. It was suggested that if the number of nominations does not exceed thirty, there may be no need to conduct an election.

15. The Core Committee was also advised to deliberate further on matters related to Section 12A registration and activities outside India. If such activities are undertaken, it may require an amendment or a legal opinion, as the organization is primarily meant to operate within India, and a PAN card alone does not constitute registration. It was further noted that appropriate registration may be required, and the same needs to be ensured.

16. Amendments of the by-laws have also been discussed between the advisory committee, and they are going to do the homework with the help of Advocate Shyam Dewani, and will discuss it on 13th May 2026.

17. The auditor should be appointed in Mumbai itself. Again, we will take help from Advocate Shyam Dewani, being a local authority. Maybe he will guide us on whom we can appoint. It cannot be appointed by the governing council, but a temporary appointment can be made until it is passed in the general body meeting.

18. One more suggestion has been made that a minimum of ten members should be appointed to the committee. The core committee will begin working on this accordingly.

19. Additionally, individuals should be appointed as in-charge of different committees, such as a spokesperson and other roles, from among the committee members, governing council members, or those who have been involved with VSHFA so far. This will enable them to independently take charge of various responsibilities. There should also be involvement of women and youth in these committees. A few young members and women can be appointed among the thirty-plus committee members to ensure broader participation and representation.
20. A physical meeting has been scheduled on **25th April 2026 at 2:00 PM** at Balgandarwa Auditorium, with a few core committee members, the event management team, and other participants. The meeting will focus on discussing the event and conducting necessary negotiations with all concerned.
21. Dr. Vinky Rughwani and Shri Satendra Kumar Bhavnani ji have willingly promised donations of ₹25,000 (twenty-five thousand) each for this program.
22. Shri Ishwar Jhamnani ji has proposed the name of Dr. Mohan Manghnani for inclusion as a governing council member or as part of the committee, so that his services can be utilized. This may be approved in the next meeting after discussing it with him personally.

23. The hotel for headquarters members has been tentatively fixed as Rang Sharda. Approximately 10 rooms have been booked by the core committee. The host committee for rooming will further coordinate within the group regarding any additional room bookings required elsewhere.

24. Blessings were given by Hon. Shankar Lalwani ji, who also guided that a virtual meeting of the committee regarding the Jangana (Census) should be held soon. He will be giving his attention to this as well. He also appreciated the work of each and every core member for their commendable efforts.

25. The concluding remarks were given by National President Gurmukh Jagwani ji. He appreciated the efforts and stated that this program would be one of the “talk of the town” and even better than the Vigyan Bhavan, Delhi program.

26. Vote of thanks was given by Governing Council Member Shri D.R. Wadhwani ji.

27. The meeting was adjourned by National President Dr. Gurmukh Jagwani ji at 10:38 PM.
